*The lords abode & holy bath*

Mount Kailash is the epitome of spiritual and natural bliss. Situated in Tibet, it is one of the most revered and sacred places on earth among Hindus, Jains and Buddhists alike. Pilgrimage to it is considered as the pathway to emancipation from earthly sins and pathway to spiritual enlightenment. Considered as the abode of Lord Shiva and his consort Parvati among Hindus, only a few lucky thousand every year are allowed to make pilgrimage to this holy site. While it has different names in different religions, its spiritual significance remains of paramount importance among all of them. Making a parikrama or Kailash Kora around Mount Kailash is considered as a way to emancipate from life-cycles and rebirth and to be one with the spiritual center of the universe. Taking holy bath in Lake Mansarovar, believed to be created by Lord Brahma and resided by Lord Shiva, purges sins of a hundred yonis and sanctifies human soul of miseries.

Throughout human history, Mount Kailash pilgrims have shared tales of the divine experience during their pilgrimage to Mount Kailash. Whether you are Hindu, Buddhist or Jain- Mount Kailash is your pathway to be close and be one with the divine in this very life.

Day 09	Trek to Zuthulphuk (4790/22km/8-10 hrs) via crossing Dolma-La Pass (5630m).
Day 10	Trek down to Darchen and drive to Saga.
Day 11	Drive to Kyirong. Last night staying in Tibet, China.
Day 12	Drive to Rasuwagadi Border, complete the immigration formalities and drive to Kathmandu.
Day 13	Transfer to Airport for final departure.

## Kailash Mansarovar Heli Tour-11 Days

Day 01	Kathmandu Arrival. Transfer to Hotel. Further program briefing.
Day 02	Morning visit Pashupatinath Temple. Afternoon fly to Nepalgunj/arrive from LUCKNOW.
Day 03	Transfer to Airport/fly to Simikot (2950m). Rest of the time is free.
Day 04	Fly to Hilsa by Helicopter. Complete the immigration formalities and drive to Purang (3750m/30km).

This is trip loaded with all Shiva imagery and significance. Located just 7 kilometres from Mansarovar's shore, the Lapcha La pass straddles the border between Nepal and Tibet.

Paying your respects by bowing to the majestic peak of Kailash is once-in-a-life time opportunity that only a few get. The Lapcha La Pass offers a splendid view of the entirety of Mount Kailash. It is the best you can get near to the lord of lords – Mahadev.


Day 01	Arrival at Lucknow airport/railway station and drive to Nepalgunj (182km/5hrs). Further program briefing in the evening.
Day 02	After the breakfast transfer to airport/fly fly to simikot (55min/2950m). Free day for acclimatization, visit shiva temple.
Day 03	After the breakfast drive to kermi villag (2785m/23km/03 hrs) via crossing salle khola (river). Rest of the time is for acclimatization.
Day 04	After the breakfast at camp, drive to tukling (47km/4150m/05-06 hrs) via crossing chhongs valley (Kharka), Sheliman Lake, Nelu pass (5600m) and talung valley.
Day 05	In the morning drive to lapcha view point (4900m/26km/03 hrs). Packed lunch will serve in lapcha. From the view point you will have panoramic view of lake mansarovar, kailash parvat and astapath. From lapcha lake mansarovar is 08 km and kailash is 46 km nautical distance. After kailash darshan, drive back to tukling.
Day 06	After the breakfast at camp, we will proceed to simikot. Packed lunch will serve on the way. Night halt in simikot.
Day 07	After breakfast fly to nepalgunj and drive to lucknow, drop to the airport. End of the tour.



## Muktinath Tour *Stairway to salvation*

Muktinath is a sacred place for both Hindus and Buddhists located at the foot of the Thorong La mountain pass in Mustang. It is a religious shrine that has equal power to spell bound you with its natural beauty and its warm yet chilled cold weather. People of both faiths consider it as a place for attaining salvation. Bathing in the 108 natural water sprouts in the premises of the temple is considered holy by people of both faiths equally. Since ancient times many Hindu Sadhus and Buddhist monks have done penance at this holy site and affirmed it as a place to attain emancipation from the cycle of life and death. ## *Into The Forbidden Kingdom*




# White Water Rafting
